Dear WUHS Families,

Due to a high risk of community transmissions, and WUHS being identified as having an outbreak in western Racine County, **a decision was made to move to a hybrid model of instruction beginning on Monday, October 12** through the end of October. No decisions have been made yet regarding November.

Students will be rotating between in-person and virtual instruction based on the first letter of their last name. Please view the attached schedule for all in-person and virtual days from October 12 through the end of the month. Please save and keep the schedule in a visible location at your home so that students are aware of their daily responsibilities.

How will the hybrid work?

The hybrid platform will include:

- Students attending an in-person day will be at school as they would during a normal day.
- Students attending virtually are expected to log-on synchronously, at the correct time, to their classes from home.
- All classes will be streamed each hour with attendance taken both in-person and virtually.
- Links for virtual, synchronous streaming can be accessed in the student's Google Classroom or via email links from their teacher.

Notes about the rotating schedule

- The schedule begins on Monday, October 12 with students A-K in-person and L-Z virtual. The schedule begins Monday with a "Day 4" rotation in order to maintain continuity from last week's learning.
- Please note that the rotation between in-person and virtual has built-in days where students will have two consecutive virtual or two consecutive in-person days (between Days 3 and 4). This format is in place to ensure equal touches, both virtually and in-person, for all the classes on a student's schedule.
- Students at home because of a required quarantine period should log-on virtually every day, regardless of the last-name rotation.
- All Juniors will attend, in-person, for the Practice ACT exam on Tuesday, October 20. Additional information will be sent directly to these students.
