## Acceptable Use of Personal Wireless Devices during WUHS School Hours

**SOCIAL NETWORKING REMINDER:** Using wireless devices to post video, audio, or still images of others to tease, ridicule, or harm someone else is **wrong**. Be respectful of others.

## To our Waterford students:

Many of you own wireless devices such as Kindles, Nooks, tablets, iPads, netbooks, and laptops.

The Waterford Union High School Board passed board policy that allows for the responsible use of laptops, netbooks, and tablets, with screens larger than 7", in school for learning.

The goals of allowing students to use their own devices in school are:

- 1) Further the educational aims of the district
- 2) Increase the accessibility to technology-related curriculum materials
- 3) Personalize learning

This pamphlet will help you learn what uses of wireless devices are considered acceptable and unacceptable in your school. All policies are tied to safety and respect. If you have questions, be sure to ask a staff member. **Be responsible with your wireless use at all times!**

## In Class:

### Allowed with Teacher Permission Only:

- Device (to include cell phones) use in the classroom for accessing safe, harmless web-sites related to class instruction.
- Listening to appropriate video/ audio with **one** earpiece; **audio must not be heard by those near you.**
- Picture-taking / Recording

### Prohibited at all Times:

- Earphones in both ears
- Talking on the phone during class
- Accessing Inappropriate, Unsafe, or Disruptive Materials
- Singing, tapping feet, etc.
- Violating board policy
- Texting
- Noneducational Games

### Bottom Line for Classrooms:

**ALL WIRELESS DEVICE USE IN CLASSROOMS MUST BE WITH THE INSTRUCTOR'S APPROVAL.**



## In Study Halls:

### Allowed without Teacher Permission:

- Accessing safe, harmless web-sites for school or personal hobby purposes. **Websites must be for your eyes only, not for those around you. You or a teacher should be the only people who see your screen.**
- Listening to appropriate video/ audio with **one** earpiece; **audio must not be heard by those near you.**

### Allowed with Teacher Permission:

- Picture-taking / Recording

### Prohibited at all Times:

- Earphones in both ears
- Talking on the Phone
- Accessing Inappropriate, Unsafe, or Disruptive Materials
- Singing, tapping feet, etc.
- Violating board policy
- Texting

State law prohibits use of wireless devices in **restrooms**, **locker rooms**, or other areas where **privacy** is expected.
