

## Sophomore Exam Exemption Information

Beginning in the 2019-20 school year, all sophomores who meet the grade, attendance and disciplinary requirements for exemptions will be allowed one (1) final exam exemption during the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester.

If a sophomore student has scored in the Exceeding category on at least 3 of the 4 areas of their freshman ASPIRE test, they will be eligible for one (1) final exam exemption during the 1<sup>st</sup> semester, as well as being eligible for two (2) exemptions during the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester.

If a sophomore student has scored in the Ready or Exceeding category on 4 of the 4 areas of their freshman ASPIRE test, they will be eligible for two (2) final exam exemptions during the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester only.

### Grade Requirements:

Any sophomore student meeting the criteria listed above will be required to have a grade of least an A- in both quarters leading up to the exemption.

### Attendance Requirements:

Students may have no more than 5 excused absences. This includes pre-excused absences.

### Disciplinary Requirements:

Students may receive no office referrals during the semester in which the exemption is earned.
